SUMMER PACKING LIST

What to Pack:

Welcome to the mountains! At 7,800 feet, summer days can reach the high 80s, while nights cool down to the mid-40s. Weather changes fast, and afternoon showers are common—so layers are your best friend.

LOTHING & FOOTWEAR ESSENTIALS: Plan to get a little dusty--we're more a ranch than a resort. Casual, comfortable clothes are perfect Light waterproof jacket with a hood (for sudden showers) L T-shirts, long sleeves, and fleece or sweaters for layering **Jeans** for horseback riding (3+ pairs recommended) Shorts and swimsuits for warm days and water activities Riding boots with a heel and smooth sole (no sneakers or hiking boots) Hiking boots for trails, plus wool socks to avoid blisters Water shoes or old sneakers for river fun Sneakers or casual shoes for general wear Slippers for cabin lounging Optional: Bike shorts if you plan to mountain bike (they're also great for horseback riding!) WHAT YOU DON'T NEED TO BRING CCESSORIES & PERSONAL ITEMS: I Fly fishing gear--we've got rods, reels, boots, and waders | Hat and sunglasses Mountain bikes and helmets--provided for all guests Sunscreen and bug spray Hairdryer, watter bottles, toiletries, coffee maker, mini-Allergy meds and Ibuprofen (aka Vitamin I) fridge--all included in your room! Riding gloves (helpful on cool mornings) Backpack or fanny pack for adventures "Cowboy Up" outfit (if you want to dress western for dinner!) TECH TIPS:
